Jax wasn't in rescue long before Jill and Marcel discovered what a fabulous guy he is!

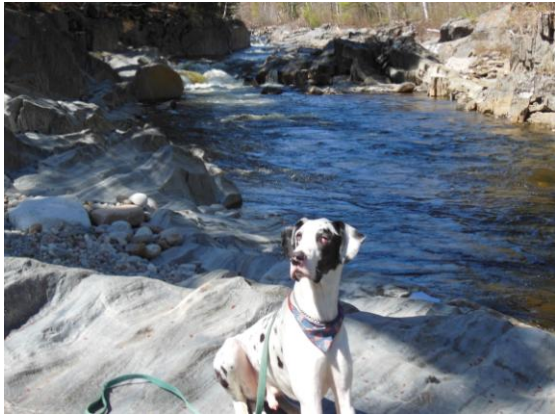
